



## Trilogy Gymnastics Weather Policy

### Purpose

The safety of our athletes, families, and staff is our top priority. This Weather Policy outlines how the club will respond to inclement or hazardous weather conditions and how decisions regarding class cancellations or closures will be communicated.

### Weather Conditions That May Affect Operations

Classes, practices, and events may be delayed, modified, or canceled due to:

Severe storms (thunderstorms, lightning, high winds)

Snow, ice, or hazardous road conditions

Extreme temperatures (heat or cold)

Flooding or other dangerous weather-related conditions

Power outages or facility safety concerns caused by weather

### Decision-Making Process

The club monitors local weather forecasts, road conditions, and school district closures.

Decisions are made with athlete and staff safety as the primary consideration.

Whenever possible, decisions will be made at least 2–3 hours before scheduled classes. In rapidly changing conditions, decisions may be made closer to class time.

### Communication

Weather-related updates will be communicated through:

Email to registered families

Club website and/or social media pages

Club communication app or text alerts (if applicable)

Families are responsible for checking these channels before traveling to the gym during questionable weather conditions.

### Class Cancellations & Make-Ups

If the club cancels a class due to weather, make-up classes, credits, or refunds will be handled according to the club's general attendance and tuition policy.

If the club remains open but a family chooses not to attend due to weather, the absence will be considered excused, but make-ups are not guaranteed unless stated in the club's policies.

### During-Class Weather Emergencies

In the event of severe weather (e.g., fire warning) during class time, athletes and staff will follow the facility's emergency safety procedures.

Athletes will be supervised at all times until it is safe for dismissal or until they are picked up by a parent/guardian.

### Travel Discretion

Even if the gym remains open, families should use their own judgment when deciding whether it is safe to travel. The club fully supports families choosing safety first.
