



Gymnastics Club – Terms and Conditions

1. Enrolment

Enrolment is confirmed once the completed enrolment form is received and all applicable fees are paid.

Places in classes are limited and allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Enrolments are for the full term unless otherwise stated.

2. Fees and Payments

Fees must be paid in full prior to the commencement of the term unless a payment plan has been approved.

All fees are non-refundable, except where required under Australian Consumer Law.

Missed classes due to illness, holidays, or other personal reasons are not refundable.

Replacement classes may be offered at the club's discretion and are subject to availability.

Late payments may incur additional fees or result in suspension of participation.

3. Cancellations and Withdrawals

Written notice of 30 days is required for withdrawal from a class.

Withdrawal partway through a term does not entitle the participant to a refund.

The club reserves the right to cancel or change classes, coaches, or timetables if necessary. Where possible, reasonable notice will be given.

4. Medical Information

Parents/guardians must disclose all relevant medical conditions (including asthma, allergies, or injuries) at the time of enrolment.

It is the responsibility of parents/guardians to ensure medical details are kept up to date.

In the event of an emergency, the club may seek medical treatment for the participant at the parent/guardian's expense.

5. Health and Safety

Participants must be fit to participate in gymnastics activities.

The club reserves the right to exclude any participant who is unwell or whose behaviour poses a safety risk.

All gymnastics activities involve an element of risk. By enrolling, participants acknowledge and accept these risks.

6. Behaviour and Conduct

All participants, parents, and spectators must comply with the club's Codes of Conduct.

Bullying, harassment, abusive language, or unsafe behaviour will not be tolerated.

The club reserves the right to suspend or terminate enrolment due to serious or repeated breaches of behaviour expectations. No refund will be provided in these circumstances.

7. Supervision

Children are only supervised during their scheduled class time.

Parents/guardians are responsible for the supervision of children before and after classes.

Siblings not enrolled in classes must be supervised at all times and are not permitted on any equipment.

8. Photography and Media

The club may take photographs or videos during classes or events for promotional purposes.

By enrolling, parents/guardians consent to the use of images unless they advise the club in writing otherwise.

9. Insurance and Liability

The club holds appropriate insurance in accordance with industry standards.

To the extent permitted by law, the club is not liable for loss, damage, or injury sustained during participation, except where caused by negligence.

10. Privacy

Personal information is collected for enrolment, safety, and communication purposes only.

Information is handled in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth).

Personal details will not be shared without consent, except where required by law.

11. Uniform and Equipment

Participants must wear appropriate gymnastics attire.

Long hair must be tied back and jewellery removed before class.

The club is not responsible for lost or stolen personal items.

12. Amendments

The club reserves the right to update these Terms and Conditions at any time.

Updated terms will be made available via the club's website or communication channels.

13. Acceptance of Terms

By enrolling in the gymnastics program, parents/guardians acknowledge they have read, understood, and agree to these Terms and Conditions.
