



Parent / Guardian Code of Conduct Policy

Trilogy Gymnastics

1. Purpose

Trilogy Gymnastics is committed to providing a safe, supportive, and positive environment for all gymnasts. This Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct outlines the expectations of behaviour for parents and guardians involved in the club.

2. Scope

This policy applies to:

All parents and guardians of gymnasts

All club activities, including training, competitions, events, and communications

Behaviour on club premises, at competitions, and online

3. General Expectations

Parents and guardians are expected to:

Treat all gymnasts, coaches, staff, officials, and families with respect

Support the club's values, policies, and coaching decisions

Promote good sportsmanship and positive behaviour

Communicate respectfully and constructively

4. Supporting Athletes

Parents and guardians should:

Encourage effort, enjoyment, and personal improvement

Allow coaches to coach without interference

Avoid sideline coaching or distracting behaviour

Support athletes regardless of performance or results

5. Communication with Coaches and Staff

Concerns should be raised calmly and respectfully

Coaching matters should be discussed at appropriate times, not during training

Appointments should be requested for in-depth discussions

Emergency or urgent matters should be directed to club management

6. Behaviour at Training and Competitions

Parents and guardians must not:

Use abusive, threatening, or offensive language

Harass or intimidate coaches, officials, athletes, or other families

Undermine coaching decisions or club policies

Enter training areas without permission

Engage in behaviour that compromises safety or wellbeing

7. Child Safety and Privacy

Parents and guardians must:

Respect child safety policies and procedures

Follow photography and filming guidelines

Not take photos or videos of other gymnasts without consent

Report any child safety concerns immediately

8. Online Conduct

Online communication must be respectful and appropriate

Negative or harmful comments about athletes, coaches, or the club on social media are not acceptable

Confidential information must not be shared online

9. Breaches of the Code

Breaches of this Code may result in:

Verbal or written warnings

Restrictions on attendance or communication

Suspension or termination of the athlete's enrolment in serious cases

Disciplinary action will be managed in line with the club's policies and principles of procedural fairness.

10. Complaints

Concerns or complaints should be raised in accordance with the club's Complaints and Compliments Policy.

11. Policy Review
